ENTRY AND RULES

1. Tractor must be regular stock model, except on Hot Rod Class. No implements attached.

2. Drawbar must not be over 18 inches high. Either 3 point or straight draw bar, but no combination of the two. Differential lock must be disengaged.

3. All contestants enter at their own risk.

4. A tractor may be entered in two classes, with not more than two entries per class.

5. All drivers must be 16 years old or older, and if under 21, must have written permission of parents or guardian. Auto driver's license will be evidence of age.

6. Contest open to rubber-tired farm tractors. Rear duals, chains or front wheel drives not eligible or permitted to compete.

7. Drawbar height maximum of 18 inches from ground to top of drawbar. Drawbar cannot be raised or lowered during pull. Drawbars must be regular factory built equipment (or facsimile). No chains attached.

8. Driver of tractor must remain seated at all times during pull and will be disqualified for touching the gear shift lever or clutch, except to stop and except to change gears in first 10 feet of pull. Driver

must keep one hand on steering wheel at all times. The front wheels not to leave the ground more than 6 inches.

9. No weight changes or weight shifting or driver changes after the tractor and driver have been officially weighed in. All weights must be bolted or fastened securely to the tractor and not over 24 inches ahead of tractor's main frame nor to extend beyond the hitch point in the rear.

10. Maximum speed not to exceed 5 1/2 miles per hour.

11. Disqualified if unable to move skid in three attempts.

12. Careless or reckless driving will not be tolerated.

13. The contest will be governed by 3 judges with all decisions final.

14. Tractor must be weighed in between 9:00 and 11:30 at the Johnson & Tuttle Elevator.

15. No traction boosting equipment will be allowed.

16. I agree to abide by the rules as set forth and agree not to hold the Booster Club or the Committee responsible for any accidents that might occur during this contest.

Each contestant to furnish own clevis and pin.
