

Farmers Order ^{2/15/} 30,000 Trees ⁶³

Farmers in Davis county have already ordered nearly 30,000 pine trees for 1963 planting, according to Verle Arnold of the Soil Conservation Service office here.

He said other farmers planning to plant trees this spring should send in their orders soon.

Planting stock available includes Austrian Pine, White Pine, Red Pine and Scotch Pine. The trees cost \$22 per thousand, but ACP cost-sharing funds are available for this program. Cost-sharing can amount to 80 per cent of the cost of trees and planting, but can't exceed \$45 an acre.

Special packets of wildlife cover are available at \$4.50 each and can be used around ponds and for planting other "odd" areas on most farms.
