Mrs. Gust Richerodt submitted to a painful operation at the Englewood hospital Saturday when it was necessary to break one of her shoulders to correct a fracture of the bones resulting from a runaway accident last winter. The ligaments had adhered so readily that it was necessary to break the joint again on Sunday. Mrs. Richerodt suffers great pain, but there will no doubt be perfect adhesion.

Gust Richerodt, one of the leading farmers in the French Grove settlement, came to town Saturday with two cases and a washtubful of eggs, there being 97 dozen in all. Asked if his hens laid them all, Mr. Richerodt admitted that he shucked some from his egg plants. Others in the same neighborhood are reported as having delivered large consignments of eggs also. One farmer had 130 dozen. At 16 and 17 cents a dozen for eggs the hens on a farm are a better investment than milk cows.

Mr. and Mrs. Gust. Richerodt, who live north of town, celebrated their 30th wedding anniversary last Thursday. Their guests numbered upwards of one hundred, and all enjoyed a pleasant time.

E. R. Wyatt has sold his property in the northeast part of town to Gust Richerodt, the consideration being \$4,000. Mr. Richerodt may have possession December 1st, but he will probably not move to town until spring, as it may not be possible for him to leave his farm before that time. Mr. Wyatt will retire, but he will not leave State Center. He will either rent or build a place and continue to make his home here.
