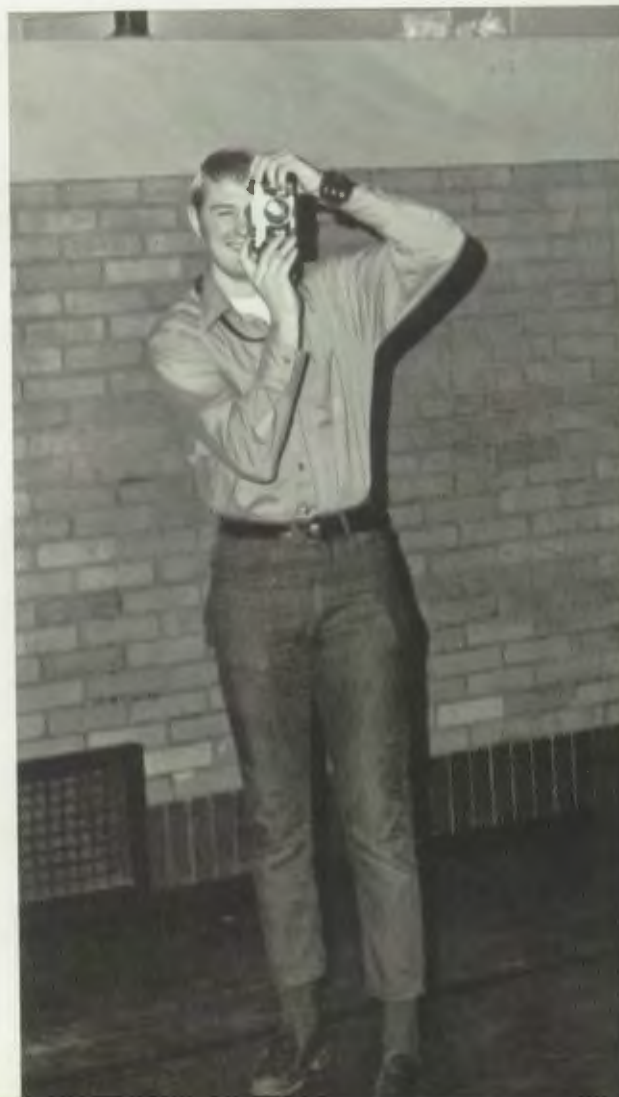

the bullpups team consisted of several "very fine individuals that should really help the varsity," assistant coach lawson predicted.

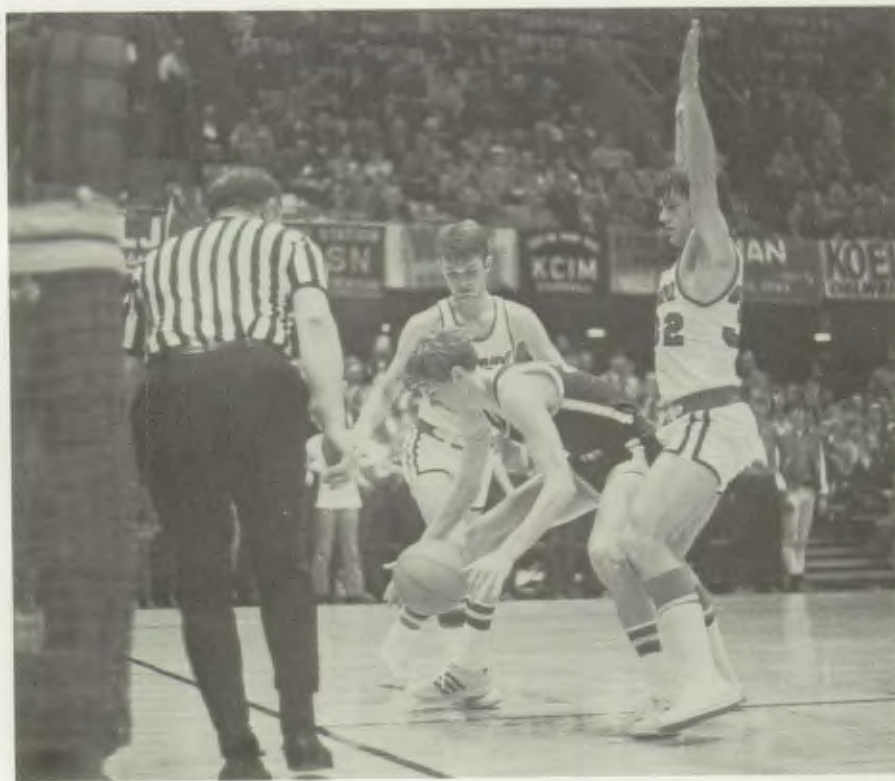

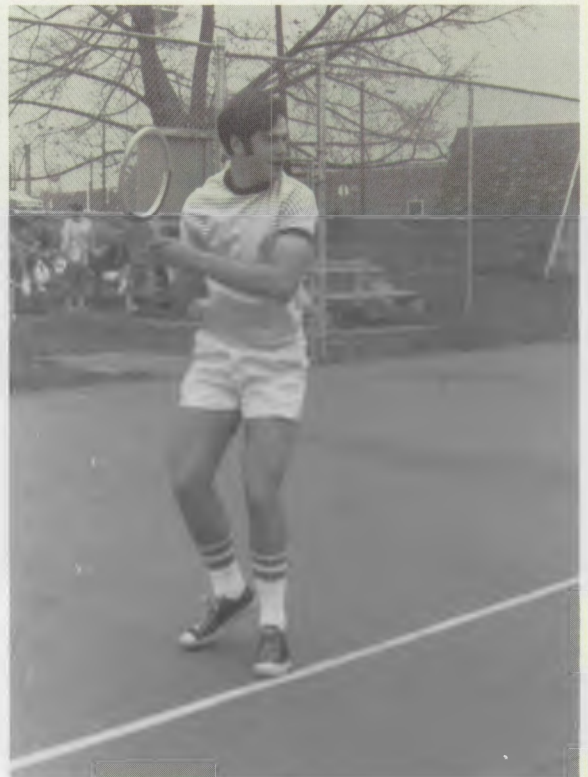

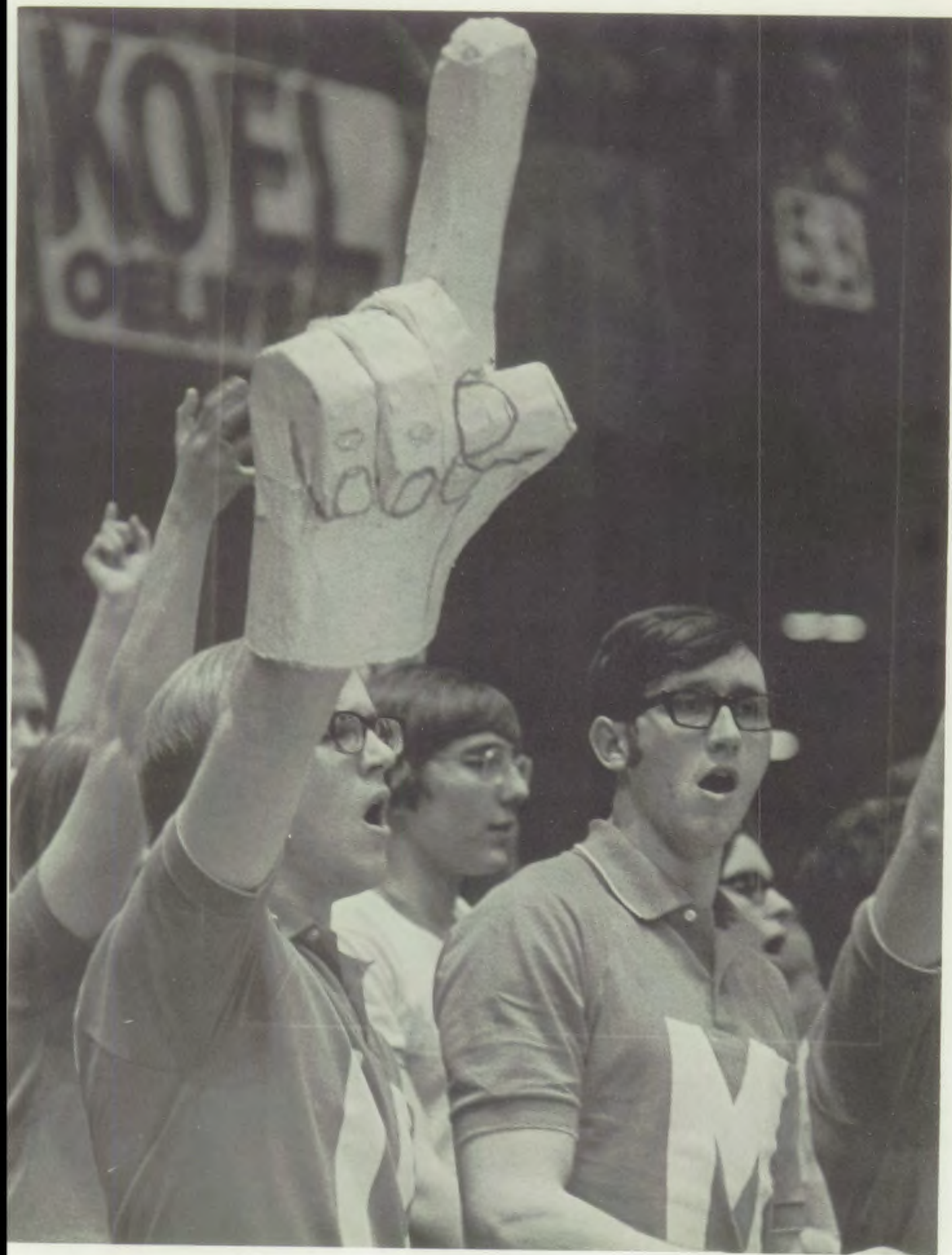
the o.h.s. boys golf team finished another fine season winning 9 dual meets and losing 2. in addition to this record, the bulldogs won all major meets in southeast iowa.

seniors on the squad include steve caves, max simpson and rick shumaker.

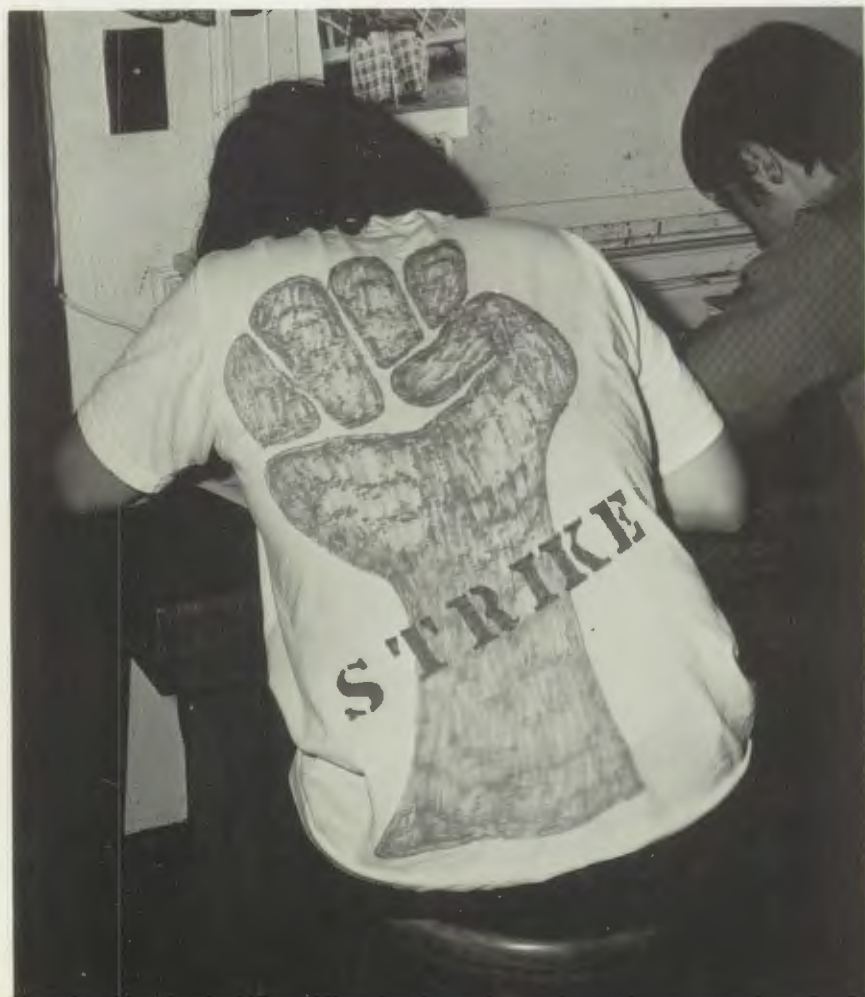

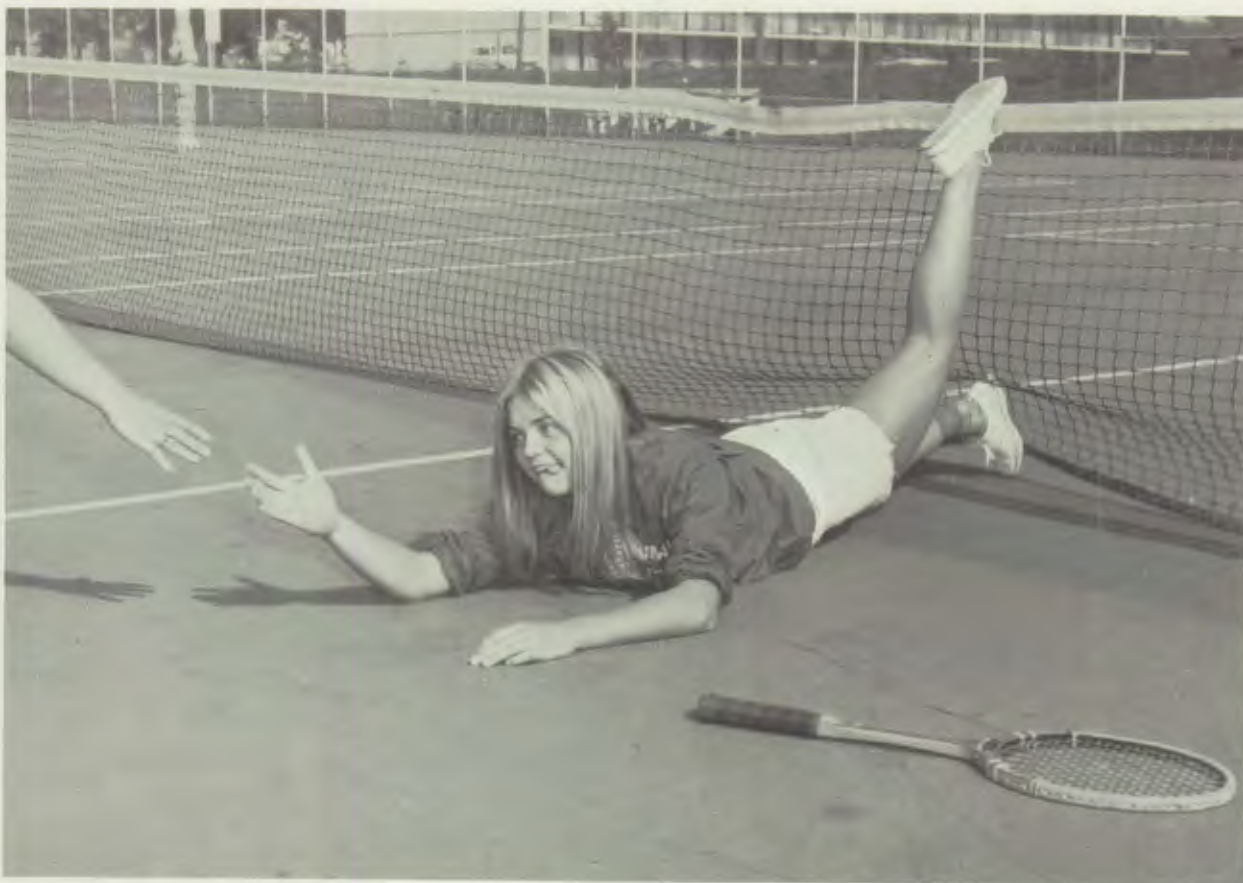
