Mrs. R. E. Zink of Beaman, pianist, and her daughters, Mrs. Joe Kinniard and Miss Dorothea Zink, who play the marimba, presented nuptial music followed by "The Bridal Chorus" from "Lohengrin" (Wagner) as the processional and Mendelssohn's wedding march following the ceremony.

Paul Parker of Gilman sang "Because", accompanied by his mother, Mrs. James Parker, as the candles were lighted by Mrs. Donald Kaufmann and Mrs. Ronald Kaufmann. Following the ceremony Mr. Parker sang "O Promise Me."

Mrs. John Zink served as matron of honor and Miss Rita Lynch, sister of the bridegroom, was bridesmaid. The best man was John Zink.

The bride, who was given in marriage by her father, was attired in a white slipper satin gown, fashioned with a tight basque and a full skirt. Her fingertip veil fell from a coronet of seed pearls and she carried a colonial bouquet tied with white ribbons.

The matron of honor wore a yellow net gown and the bridesmaid wore an aqua blue silk gown. Both carried colonial bouquets.

Following the ceremony a reception was held in the church parlors for 115 guests. Mrs. Jack Rattray was parlor hostess. A three tier wedding cake and crystal candle holders with mirrored tapers formed the centerpiece.
