

Conservation Air Tour Scheduled

A Conservation Air Tour of conservation practices in Davis County has been scheduled for Sunday by the Davis County Soil Conservation District.

The district, with the aid of local pilots, are making arrange-

ments for the tour.

Harold Baughman, chairman of the district, said that advance tickets only would be sold. He said the tickets would be \$3 to cover the expenses of operating the planes.

He said the tickets may be purchased at the Soil Conservation Service office in Bloomfield or from district commissioners. Commissioners are Baughman, Sam Botts Jr. and Iles Heady.

Robert Hockersmith, manager of the Bloomfield Airport, said that each rural passenger would have a chance to fly over his own farm and that each flight will be approximately 20 to 25 minutes in length.

Hockersmith said each plane will carry three passengers and will be open to the public. He said three and, possibly four, planes will be available for the tour.

In event of rain, the tour will be held one week later, June 26.
