KOSSUTH COUNTY SOIL CONSERVATION
DISTRICT COMMISSIONER ORGANIZATION MEETING

Algona, Iowa
March 14, 1947

Members present - George Hagge, J. C. Skow and Frank Droessler.

Others - L. E. Clapp, Extension Soil Conservationist; L. E. Kuester, Soil Conservation Service and A. L. Brown, County Extension Director.

The meeting was called to order by A. L. Brown, acting as temporary chairman.

The first order of business was an explanation and discussion of the powers and duties of the county commissioners by L. E. Clapp and L. E. Kuester.

The chair then announced that the first official act would be that of selecting a chairman and that nominations would be received accordingly.

Nominations were received for all three commissioners. A written ballot was taken, resulting in a tie vote. The chair authorized a second ballot, the result of which gave two votes to George Hagge. He was then declared elected and instructed to take over the duties of chairman.

By mutual agreement, A. L. Brown was authorized to serve as secretary.

Moved by Frank Droessler and seconded by J. C. Skow that Algona, Iowa, be designated as the official place of business. Motion carried.

Moved by J. C. Skow and seconded by Frank Droessler that the secretary file a request with Frank Mendell, State Soil Conservation Service, for assistance in preparing a county program of work. Motion carried.

Moved by J. C. Skow and seconded by Frank Droessler that a request also be filed with Frank Mendell for assistance, at an early date, in preparation of conservation surveys. Motion carried.

Moved by Frank Droessler and seconded by J. C. Skow that the Kossuth County Soil Conservation District enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with the Iowa Agricultural Extension Service. Motion carried.

Moved by Frank Droessler and seconded by J. C. Skow that the Kossuth District adopt the policy of giving group requests for help priority over individual requests. Motion carried.

For the consideration of general problems that might be incorporated into a work plan, it was agreed that a second meeting be held Wednesday, March 19, starting at 10:00 a. m. For assistance in this meeting, as well as for assistance in the preparation of a statement of problems, a request was made for W. T. Maakstead's help.

The matter of establishing a regular monthly meeting date was considered, but definite action deferred to a later date.
