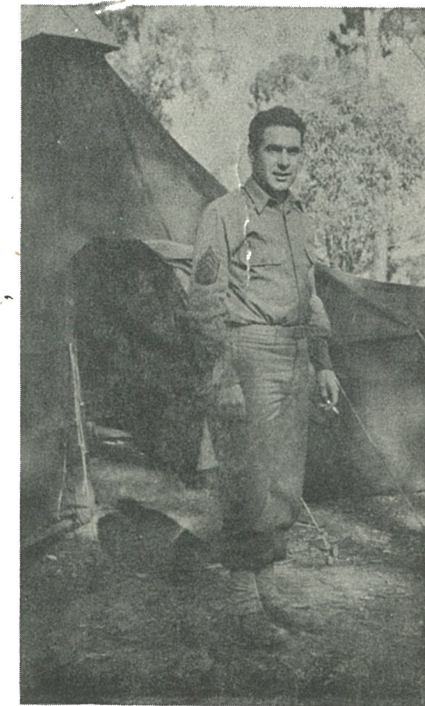




S/Sgt. ROBERT L. SANDERSON

Son of Mr. and Mrs. Robert C. Sanderson.
Inducted into Army June 15, 1944, at Camp Dodge, Iowa.
Attended Camps at Ft. Lewis, Washington, Camp Beale, California, Ft. Lawton, Washington. Went to Anchorage, Alaska, with Railroad Battalion, transferred to Camp Claiborne, Louisiana, and then to Ft. Eustis, Virginia. Received Good Conduct Medal, Meritorious Service Citation, Sharpshooters Medal.
Honorably Discharged June 3, 1946, at Ft. Leavenworth, Kansas.



1st. M/Sgt. LOUIS F. SANDERSON

Son of Mr. and Mrs. Robert C. Sanderson.
Enlisted in Army March 10, 1941 at Tulare, California.
Inducted at Los Angeles, served at Ft. MacArthur, Louisiana, Fort Sill, Oklahoma, in Field Artillery. Joined 32nd Division in Camp Livingston, Louisiana, transferred to Fort Devens, Massachusetts, then to Camp Mason, California. Left for overseas April 22, 1942. Landed in South Australia May 15, 1942, received intensive Jungle training; Combat Duty October 1943. Served in New Guinea and Dutch East Indies 30 months. Wounded by shrapnel early in 1944. Received Purple Heart, Good Conduct Medal with 5 Battle Stars. Returned to U.S. and stationed at Fort Riley, Kansas. Honorable Discharge April 12, 1945, at Jefferson Barracks, Missouri.
