Frederick was born at State Center and Elizabeth at Dillon, Ia. They were married at Dillon. They died at Marshalltown, Iowa.

Frederick Fricke was the ninth child of Christian and Caroline Schaper Fricke. He met Elizabeth Wolken when she came along with someone who delivered lumber to his parents' farm.

They married August 26, 1900 and lived on his parents farm. In 1917 they built a new home, which featured six bedrooms and a bathroom with running water, and even had an elevator type cooler which could be pulled from the basement to the attic. Many a piece of cake or pie was swiped from it when the grandchildren pulled it up to the attic for a snack.

Their were thirteen children born to this couple.

They have forty-four grand-children

one hundred nine great grand-children and (as of 7-3-82 and is
thirty eight great great grand-children. subject to change)

They raised shorthorn cattle and won many ribbons at the county fair.

Renetta married John Jacob, who came to America from Switzerland. They farmed near Baxter and Melbourne before retiring to Melbourne. They have six children. Their sons own and operate a lumberyard in Melbourne. Two daughters are married to farmers, one to a career army man and the youngest lives in Arkansas.

Ida married Clarence Frohwein, whose family were neighbors. They have two daughters and a son. Their oldest daughter farms near Laurel, Ia. Their son farms the Frohwein Farm, and the youngest daughter lives in Marshalltown. She works as a secretary at a church and her husband came from Holland as a boy.

Edna and her husband had no children and are both deceased.
