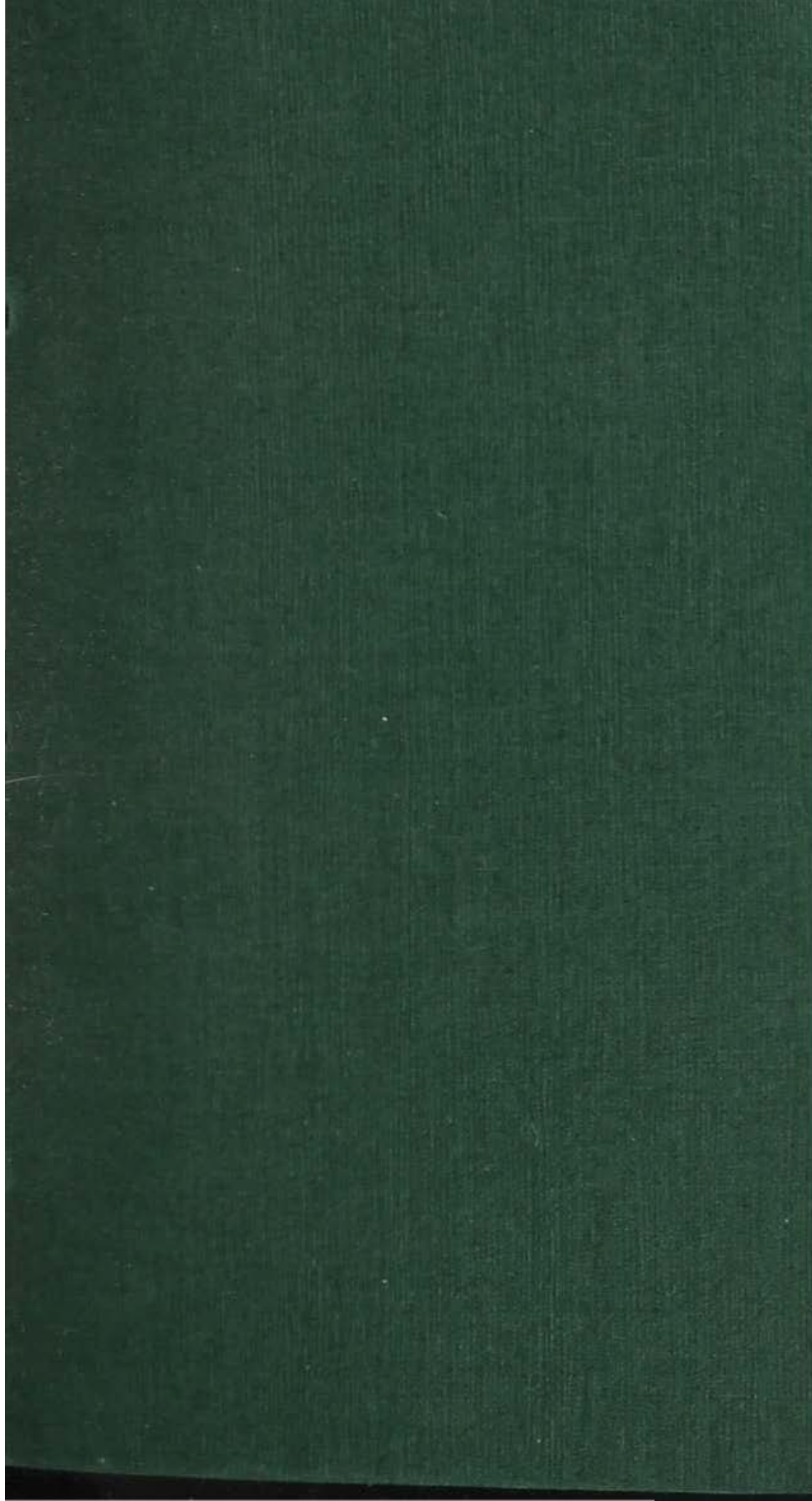

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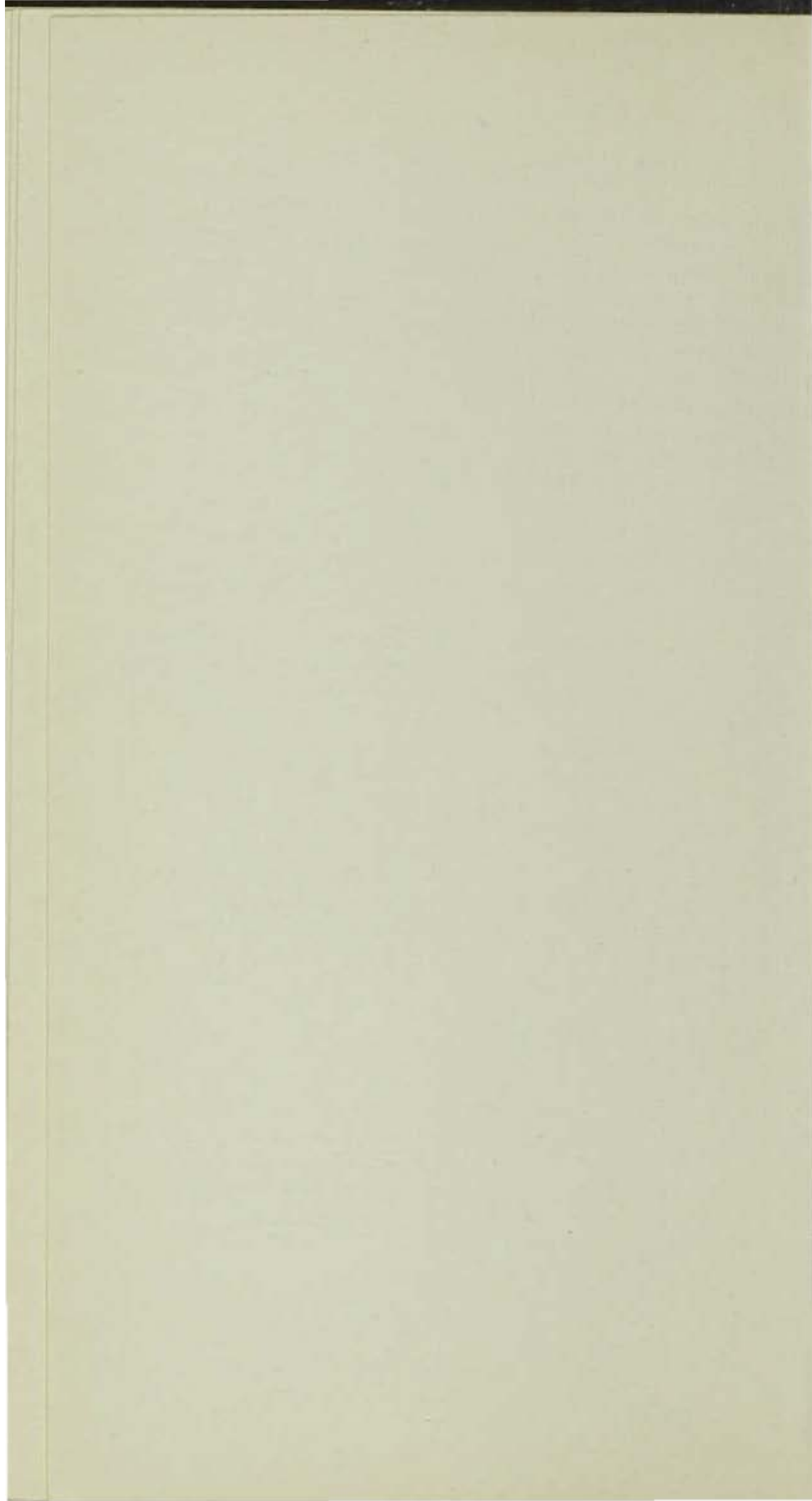

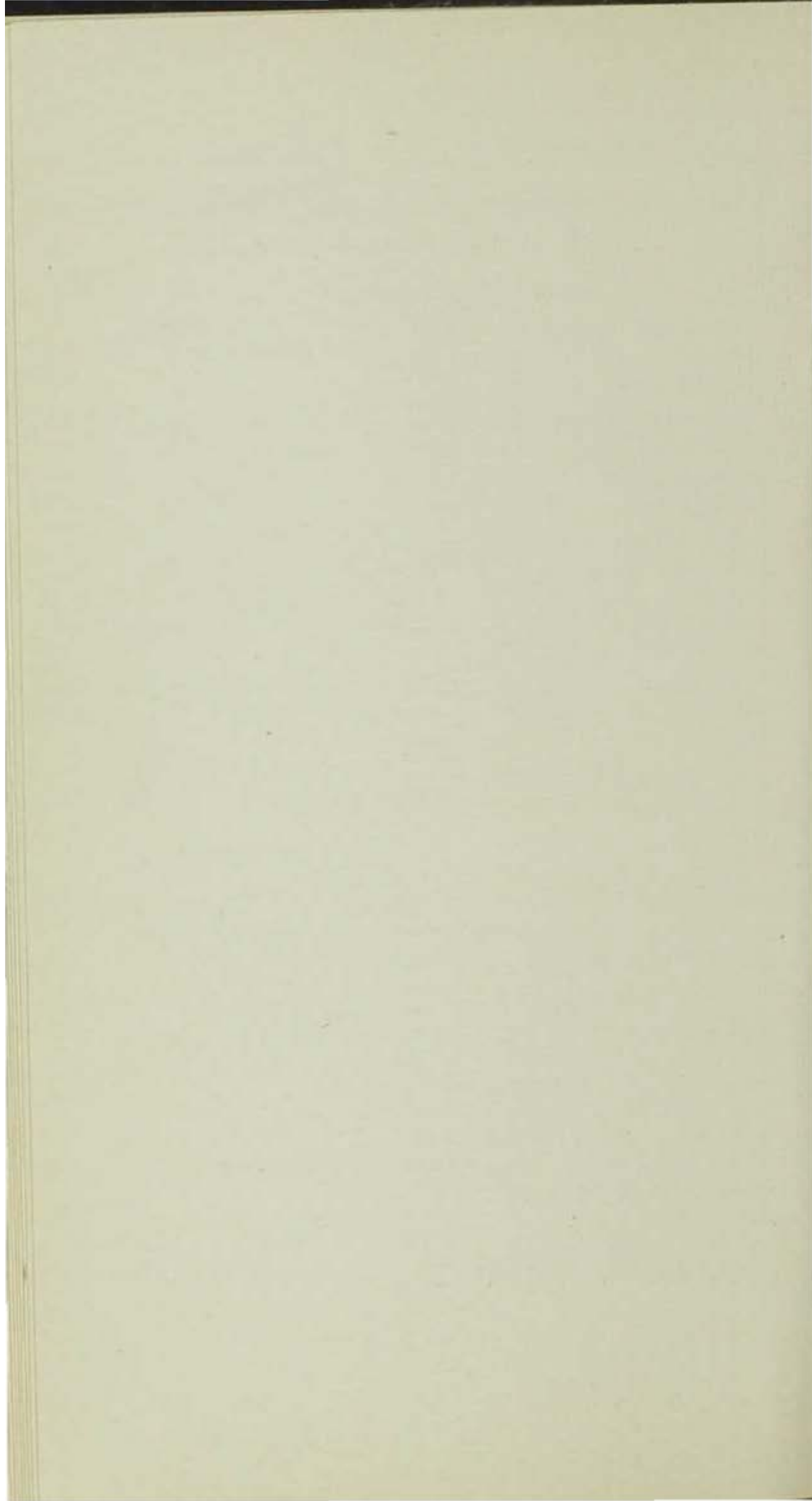
Rules for Eleventh Annual Exhibition of Des Moines Artists

Rules and Regulations

By-Laws**ARTICLE I.****NAME.**

The name of this corporation shall be the Des Moines Women's Club.

ARTICLE II.**OBJECT.**

The object of the Des Moines Women's Club shall be the establishment of an organized center of thought and action among women, mutual improvement, benevolence, and the maintenance of a free public Art Gallery.

ARTICLE III.**OFFICERS.**

SECTION 1. The officers of the Club shall be a President, First and Second Vice Presidents, Recording Secretary, Corresponding Secretary, and Treasurer.

SEC. 2. There shall be a Board of Directors consisting of twenty-five members elected annually. Any member of said Board having been elected three consecutive years is, for a period of two years, ineligible to reelection.

The service on the Directory Board for any part of a year shall count for a whole year both on the part of the outgoing and the incoming member.

Non-resident members are not eligible to places on the Directory Board.

SEC. 3. Any officer elected by the Club, not a board member, shall have the privileges of the board but shall be ineligible for election to the board for a period of two years following her term of office.

ARTICLE IV.**DEPARTMENTS.**

SECTION 1. There shall be seven departments, viz.: Art, Literature, Home and Education, Music, Social, Philosophy and Science, History and Travel.

SEC. 2. Chairmen of the various Departments shall be appointed by the President-elect. It shall be the duty of these chairmen to arrange with said department for the work of the ensuing year. A Secretary may be elected by any Department if deemed necessary.

SEC. 3. These departments shall be authorized to make only such arrangements for public entertainments as may be approved by the Board of Directors or by the unanimous vote of the Executive Committee.

ARTICLE V.

COMMITTEES.

SECTION 1. The Board of Directors shall elect annually a House Committee of three, consisting of a chairman and two assistant members. At least one of these shall be a member of the Board of Directors.

The chairman shall check rentals and all bills of House Secretary and make reports to Board of Directors.

The House Committee shall order all furnishings and supplies and make necessary repairs, subject to the approval of the Board of Directors.

The Board of Directors shall elect annually by ballot a House Secretary.

The House Secretary with the approval of the House Committee, shall engage and dismiss all employees, shall direct the work of the Club House, write all renting contracts, receive and collect for same, make all necessary preparations for Club meetings and parties, have charge of all furnishings, keep inventory of all property belonging to Club House, and make reports to House Chairman, subject to Board of Directors.

The House Committee shall have power to make House Rules, subject to the approval of the Board of Directors.

A monthly report shall be submitted to the Board of Directors by the chairman of this committee.

SEC. 2. The Board of Directors shall appoint annually a Committee on Elections which shall consist of one member from each department and a chairman who shall be a member of the Board. It shall be the duty of this committee to arrange for and conduct the annual election and the election of delegates and alternates to the General and State Federations. They shall also count the votes.

SEC. 3. The Board of Directors shall elect annually a Trustee of the Mrs. Albert Baird Cummins Memorial, whose duty shall be to act in conjunction with the Public Library Board in sustaining the Memorial, and bring reports and recommendations to the Board of the Women's Club. A Trustee having been elected three consecutive years is for a period of two years ineligible to re-election.

SEC. 4. There shall be an Art Advisory Committee of six members appointed by the President for a term of three years, two members to be appointed each year.

It shall be the duty of the committee to keep in touch with art matters, to arrange for exhibitions, and to advise in the purchase of pictures. The committee shall elect its chairman and secretary annually.

SEC. 5. The President shall appoint the following standing committees, each to consist of three members, the chairman of each to make an annual report in writing: A Calendar Committee, a Finance Committee, and a Gift Committee.

It shall be the duty of the Calendar Committee to compile and issue the Year Book. The Recording Secretary shall be a member ex-officio. The Chairman of the Calendar Committee shall be a member of the Board.

It shall be the duty of the Finance Committee to audit accounts, to prepare the Treasurer's bond, and to recommend investments to the Board. It shall also act in an advisory capacity upon questions involving appropriating money aside from the regular running expenses of the Club. This committee shall receive the books of the retiring Treasurer and after examination pass them

to the Treasurer-elect. One member of this Committee shall be a member of the Board.

It shall be the duty of the Gift Committee to examine all proposed gifts to the Art Collection and report to the Board of Directors.

A Hospitality Committee shall be appointed by the President to work under her direction.

SEC. 6. The President shall appoint the doorkeepers and ushers. They shall keep a record of the attendance of the Club at each meeting, and shall report to the Secretary before the close of the meeting names of non-resident guests with their addresses.

The President shall also appoint two chairmen to provide hostesses for the free days at the Art Gallery. They shall keep a record of attendance and report same to the Secretary of the Club.

ARTICLE VI.

DUTIES OF OFFICERS AND COMMITTEES.

SECTION 1. It shall be the duty of the President to preside at all regular and all called meetings of the Club and at all meetings of the Board of Directors. She shall be a member ex-officio of all committees. She shall be ex-officio delegate at all conventions.

SEC. 2. In the absence of the President, the Vice President, in the order of election, shall perform the duties of the President.

SEC. 3. The Recording Secretary shall keep a record of all club meetings, and of the meetings of the Board of Directors.

SEC. 4. The Corresponding Secretary shall conduct the correspondence of the Club and send all notices. She shall also perform the duties of Federation correspondent. She shall keep a correct list of club members, and shall be at her desk one-half hour before each regular meeting to answer questions and to issue tickets for non-resident guests.

SEC. 5. The Treasurer shall give a bond when she enters upon her duties. She shall take charge of all funds belonging to the Club, collect and

receive all duties and assessments, keep an account with vouchers, of all moneys received and expended, and report the same at the last meeting of the year. Each bill must be accompanied by statement and signed by the person presenting it. The bill must not be paid until endorsed by the President, and shall be paid by the Treasurer only by check. The Treasurer shall make a monthly report to the Board.

SEC. 6. The Board of Directors shall transact the business of the Club and elect members. Vacancies in said Board shall be filled by the Board, from the list of names, in consecutive order, voted for as director at the preceding annual election. Any board member who is absent from two consecutive board meetings without excuse satisfactory to the Board, thus creates a vacancy on said Board. Excuse must be sent to the Recording Secretary before adjournment. The vacancies in the Executive Board may be filled by the Board of Directors.

In the event of a vacancy in any office, the Board of Directors shall have the right to fill such vacancy until the next annual election.

ARTICLE VII.

MEMBERSHIP.

SECTION 1. To be eligible for membership in the Club a woman must have been a resident of Des Moines at least a year, unless she be a member of a Federated Club in another town, when she may be admitted on application with the customary endorsement. She must possess a ready sympathy for the objects of the Club and as far as possible actively assist in its undertakings. The number of members shall be limited to one thousand.

SEC. 2. No member shall be eligible to official position, nor be a delegate to the Biennial meetings of the G. F. W. C. and I. F. W. C., nor propose nor endorse candidates for membership until she has been a member of the Club one year.

SEC. 3. Applications for Membership must be filed with the Recording Secretary for presenta-

tion to the Board, upon blank furnished by the Club. An applicant must be proposed by one Club Member and endorsed by another.

SEC. 4. Applications for membership may be read to the Board of Directors at any board meeting, and shall be held over two weeks to be voted upon.

SEC. 5. To elect a member at least two-thirds of those present must have voted affirmatively; two negative votes will serve to exclude.

SEC. 6. The name of anyone who has failed of election may be proposed after one year.

SEC. 7. A member in good standing removing from the city may, at her own request, receive a letter of withdrawal that will entitle her, without payment of dues during her absence, to resume her membership in the Club.

ASSOCIATE MEMBERS.

SEC. 8. Any member, after three years' active service, may be transferred to the associate membership by the payment of seven dollars annual dues.

Any woman may become an associate member by payment of ten dollars annual dues, coming into the Club according to the regular rules of membership. All associate members shall be entitled to attend all general meetings, shall be exempt from work and fines, shall be ineligible to office, and shall be debarred from voting.

SEC. 9. Honorary members shall be limited to charter members.

ARTICLE VIII.

DUES.

SECTION 1. The initiation fee of ten dollars shall be the only payment required for the first fiscal year.

SEC. 2. Each member shall make an annual payment of five dollars. This payment is due the first Wednesday in October and must be paid by the first club meeting in February to entitle members to eligibility to office. An increase of fifty cents shall be required of each member delaying

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the payment of dues after the first meeting in February. Any candidate becoming a member after the annual election of officers in April shall be entitled to the privileges of the Club for the following club year, without further payment of dues.

SEC. 3. The membership of any person neglecting or refusing to pay the annual dues by May first, shall be considered forfeited.

SEC. 4. A payment of fifty dollars shall entitle a member to life membership, without further payment of annual dues.

ARTICLE IX.

MEETINGS.

SECTION 1. The fiscal year shall begin on the first Wednesday in October.

SEC. 2. The first meeting of the Club shall be on the first Wednesday in October each year. There shall be sixteen meetings held fortnightly during the year. The thirteenth meeting shall be called Club Welfare day and shall be arranged with reference to the particular need of the club at that time, whether it be social, or for informal discussion of matters of special interest to the club by the club members, or in whatever way shall be deemed best for the promotion of the welfare of the club; which shall be decided by the Board of Directors. There may be a holiday vacation.

SEC. 3. The annual exhibition of Des Moines Artists shall be hung and open for the public the first Wednesday in February which shall also be the second regular meeting of the Art Department.

SEC. 4. Meetings of the Board of Directors shall be held fortnightly alternating with the regular Club meetings. A quorum shall consist of nine members, if one be an officer.

SEC. 5. The annual business meeting shall be the fourteenth meeting of the year. Not later than two weeks before the annual meeting there

shall be furnished to each member of the club entitled to vote one printed list of all resident members eligible to election and also one ballot which shall contain the words "For Board of Directors Des Moines Women's Club" and numbers 1 to 25 inclusive. Each member voting shall write opposite these numbers such names of eligible members as may be her choice for directors. All ballots shall be sent to the President not later than one week before the annual meeting and on the envelope the voter shall write the word "Ballot." The twenty-five receiving the highest number of votes shall constitute the Board for the ensuing year. The Secretary shall announce the names of the new Board at the annual meeting at which time the Club shall elect the officers either from the Board of Directors elect or from those who have served on the Board. There shall be two nominees for each office, these being the two receiving the highest number of votes on a nominating ballot. If one candidate receive a two-thirds vote on the informal ballot, the informal ballot may be considered the formal ballot and the nominee declared elected. In case of withdrawal of a nominee the next highest shall be taken. No candidate receiving less than ten votes shall be placed on the election ballot. These candidates shall be voted for by ballot, and the ones respectively receiving the majority of the votes cast for each office shall be declared elected.

SEC. 6. Delegates and alternates to the Biennial meetings of the I. F. W. C. and G. F. W. C. shall be elected by ballot at the same time and in the same manner as the Board of Directors.

SEC. 7. The officers, Board of Directors, and all Chairmen shall enter upon the duties of their respective offices at the sixteenth meeting.

ARTICLE X.

TICKETS.

SECTION 1. Members and guests are required to present tickets at all meetings of the Club.

SEC. 2. Tickets for out-of-town guests, staying temporarily with members, may be secured from the Corresponding Secretary upon payment of fifty

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cents per meeting, and the freedom of the Club will be extended to them for two meetings.

SEC. 3. Complimentary tickets may be given by the President at her discretion.

Complimentary tickets may be given by the Department Chairman to all taking part in the program.

SEC. 4. A non-resident member of a Federated Club may secure a ticket from the Corresponding Secretary, and the freedom of the club will be extended to her for two meetings, provided she furnish the Secretary with her address and name of the club of which she is a member.

All complimentary tickets must be signed by the president.

SEC. 5. A member must pay fifteen cents for a duplicate club membership ticket.

ARTICLE XI.

JUNIOR MEMBERS.

Unmarried daughters of club members may become Junior members at the age of sixteen, by the payment of yearly dues of one dollar. On reaching the age of twenty-five, a Junior member may be admitted to full membership upon payment of regular annual club dues. Junior members, in order to obtain tickets, must present to the Treasurer the ticket of the member to whose family the applicant belongs and the yearly dues.

The tickets of Junior members must be presented at each meeting.

A member of the Club shall be appointed chairmen of Junior members.

Junior members shall not be eligible to office, or serve as chairmen of committees or have the right to vote.

Junior members may become regular members without initiation fee and upon payment of the annual dues shall be admitted to full membership.

ARTICLE XII.

CONTRACTS.

SECTION 1. All documentary papers of the Des Moines Women's Club shall be signed by its President and Secretary, except contracts made for renting Club House, said contracts shall be signed by the House Secretary.

SEC. 2. The President, Vice-President, Secretary, Corresponding Secretary and Treasurer shall constitute an Executive Council to decide any question that may arise in the intervals between the meetings of the Club. The President shall call meetings of the Club, on recommendation of twelve members, which meetings shall be known as "Club Days."

ARTICLE XIII.

The order of business shall be as follows:

1. Minutes of preceding meeting and business.
2. Report of Department for the Day.
3. Adjournment.

ARTICLE XIV.

The by-laws may be amended at any board meeting by a two-thirds vote of the members present, notice of such intention to amend having been given at a previous board meeting.

ARTICLE XV.

All meetings shall be governed by Roberts' Rules of Order Revised.

HOUSE RULES.

No property of any description owned by the Des Moines Women's Club shall be loaned.

A schedule of prices for renting the club house or any part thereof shall be made by the Board of Directors and giving to the renting section of the house committee. There shall be no changes in these regular prices without the consent of the Board of Directors.

Official Reports

Annual Report of Recording Secretary 1917-18

The past year, under the wise guidance of our capable president, Mrs. Gardner Cowles, has been a notable one in the annals of the Des Moines Women's Club, bringing as it has the opportunity for playing no small part in patriotic service to our country in this first year of war.

We have invested One Thousand Dollars in Liberty Bonds, and One Thousand Dollars in War Saving Stamps, and we have contributed to the following funds:

Christmas Comfort Bags for Soldiers,
French War Orphans,
Y. W. C. A. Travelers' Aid,
Food Conservation Demonstrator,
Furlough-homes in France, and
Beautifying the Base Hospital Grounds at
Camp Dodge.

The War Emergency Committee, under the efficient direction of Mrs. L. C. Kurtz, has made a survey of the club members and found that there are 132 close relatives in the service, and that practically all of the members are engaged in Red Cross Work. This Committee has also solicited the membership for the Furlough-homes Fund, and has taken charge of the Red Cross Work at the Club House on Fridays. With the consent of the Board of Directors, the Committee opened the Club House the first Monday of each month for the entertainment of the wives of Army Officers in the City. The Auxiliary to the War Emergency Committee assisted in this work, and also in the Liberty Loan Drive and the sale of War Savings Stamps.

SOCIAL DEPARTMENT.

On October 3rd, at the first meeting of the year, this department under the leadership of its six capable chairmen, afforded the Club members an opportunity of greeting the incoming officers and followed this by social hour, with delightful music by Miss Garnet Arrick, Harpist.

On January 30th, the department presented a program consisting of songs, fancy dances, and

an Irish Legend given in dramatic form by three members of the West High Faculty,—Miss Pearl Bennet, Miss Alice Loos, and Mrs. Carl Stewart.

ART DEPARTMENT.

On October 17th, the Art Department presented Mrs. Cyrus E. Perkins, of Grand Rapids, Michigan, who spoke on "Art as an Expression of Life."

On February 13th, Mr. Maurice I. Flagg, of Minneapolis, gave an illustrated lecture on "What's Wrong With Art."

At this time the prizes were awarded in the Annual Contest of Local Artists, which is fostered by the Club. The first prize of seventy-five dollars went to Mr. Claud Patterson for his canvas, "The Hill Top." The second prize of fifty dollars was awarded to Miss Louise Garst for "A Portrait Study." First honorable mention was given to Miss Edna Rounds, and second honorable mention to Miss Theo Aulmann.

This department also conducted a Poster Contest in November for all Iowa Artists, the subject being, "Saving and Serving with Hoover." The first prize of fifty dollars was won by Lester B. Keigler, of Sheffield, the second prize of twenty-five dollars, by Clifford Bernard of Iowa City.

There have been four successful art department study classes, the first being a talk by Professor Charles A. Cumming on "The Composition of Pictures." the second, an exhibit and talk on Amateur Photography by Miss Josephine Wallace; the third, a talk on William M. Chase, by Mrs. H. G. Everett; and the fourth was a visit to the art treasures of Mr. and Mrs. J. S. Carpenter, at their home, Oakwood.

In February, the Art Advisory Committee arranged an exhibition at the City Library of the paintings of Beneker and Gerberich, both pupils of Hawthorne. They also hung in the Club House two exhibits of local artists, Mrs. H. G. Everett and Miss Francis Keffer.

The Cumming Art Scholarship of one hundred dollars was given this year to Miss Mildred Cotnam.

HOME AND EDUCATION DEPARTMENT.

On October 31st, under the auspices of this department, Miss Edna C. White of Ohio University gave a talk on Food Conservation.

On January 16th, Professor Theodore G. Soares of Chicago University inspired us with his lecture on "The New Internationalism."

The department enjoyed a trip of investigation to Ames College on November 13th. It also served three "Thrift Luncheons" during the year on regular Club days.

LITERATURE DEPARTMENT.

On November 14th, this department gave a Novelty entertainment in West High Auditorium to club members and guests, which netted one hundred and twenty-seven dollars for the French War Orphans' Fund.

On April 24th, the department presented Nicholas Vachel Lindsay, modern American poet, in a program of readings; and on the same evening Mr. Lindsay was the after dinner speaker at a banquet of three hundred and eighty members and friends at Younkers' Tea Room.

PHILOSOPHY AND SCIENCE DEPARTMENT.

On November 28th, a meeting was held in the Unitarian Church, at which Dr. George Burnham Foster of Chicago University gave a splendidly patriotic lecture on "The Philosophic Basis of the War."

On February 27th, Dr. Bird T. Baldwin, of Iowa State University talked on "Juvenile Delinquency," and illustrated his lecture with slides.

HISTORY AND TRAVEL DEPARTMENT.

On January 2nd, this department presented our own Mrs. J. K. Macomber, who spoke on "The Perfidy of Prussia." Mrs. Macomber has also talked to the History Department on Russia or on France every Friday morning from October 1st to March 15th. This generous contribution to our Club year has been enjoyed by many members.

MUSIC DEPARTMENT.

On January 12th, the Music department presented the following local artists in recital: Mrs. Susan Bender Eddy, Soprano; Arcule Sheasby, Violinist; Adah Roper Harris, Pianist; with Miss Edith Usry, Accompanist.

On March 13th, the program was given by Katherine Bray Haynes, Arcule Sheasby, and Carl Schleur.

During the year this department has maintained a Club chorus under the direction of Mrs. Susan Bender Eddy, with weekly rehearsals, which has added to the enjoyment of the meetings by contributing chorus numbers and by leading in community singing.

The department closed their year with a social afternoon at the Club House.

CLUB WELFARE DAY.

On this day, March 27th, the members brought their Red Cross sewing to the Club House, and enjoyed a picnic luncheon. Reports were heard from departments and special committees, and the feature of the day was the presentation to the Club by Mrs. F. O. Green, of a large service flag with its 132 blue stars representing 18 husbands, 84 sons, 19 sons-in-law, 5 grandsons, and 6 brothers in the service.

Other gifts to the Club this year are a piece of Newcombe Pottery, from Miss Harriet Ankeny, and a large American Flag from Adjutant and Mrs. Guy Logan.

LOANS.

A painting by Professor Charles Cumming has been loaned by Mrs. J. D. Whisenand.

An Imperial Chinese Banner, painted by the Dowager Empress of China, was loaned by Mrs. E. H. Conger.

A Memorial to perpetuate the memory of Mrs. A. B. Cummins has been established in the form of a Book Collection for Children, to be placed in the City Library.

The sixteen regular meetings have been carried

out as scheduled, with the exception of the last one, which was changed to May 15th.

The average attendance has been 218.
