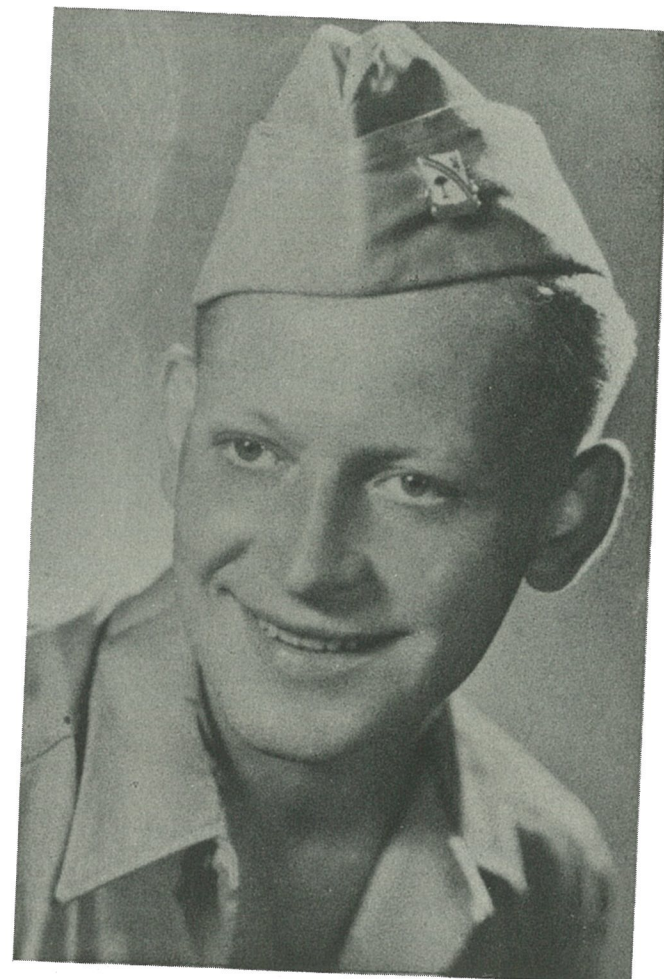




M/Sgt. MILLER ROWE

Unit Citation.
