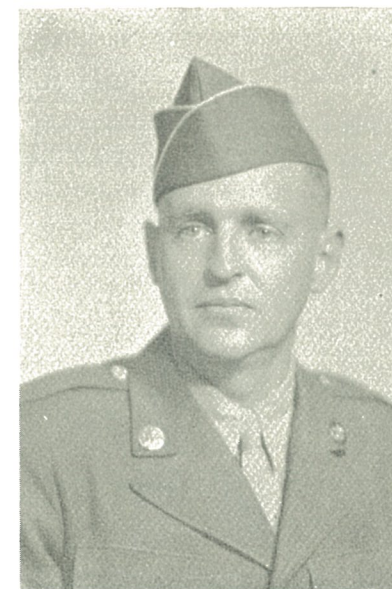




A M M 1/c PAUL ELLIOTT VINT

Asiatic-Pacific Ribbon, American Theater Ribbon, Philippine Liberation Ribbon, Victory Ribbon, Presidential Unit Citation, 4 Battle Stars, Bronze Arrowhead and Good Conduct Medal.

Honorably Discharged December 5, 1945 at Fort Leavenworth, Kansas.
